

PREFACE FOR EASTER

VERE dignum et justum est, æquum et salutäre: Te quidem, Dómine, omni tempore, sed in hoc potíssimum gloriósius prædicare, cum Pascha nostrum immolátus est Christus. Ipse enim verus est Agnus, qui ábstulit peccáta mundi. Qui mortem nostram moriéndo destrúxit, et vitam resurgéndo reparávit. Et ídeo Cum Angelis et Archángelis, cum Thronis et Dominationíbus, cumque omni milítia cæléstis exércitus, hymnum glóriæ tuæ cánimus, sine fine dicéntes:

IT is truly meet and just, right and availing unto salvation that at all times, but more especially at this season we should extol Thy glory, O Lord, when Christ our Pasch was sacrificed. For He is the true Lamb that hath taken away the sins of the world. Who by dying hath overcome our death, and by rising again hath restored our life. And therefore with angels and archangels, with thrones and dominions, and with all the heavenly hosts, we sing a hymn to Thy glory, saying without ceasing:

Cantáte Dómino, allelúia: cantáte Dómino, et benedicite nomen ejus: bene nuntiáte de die in diem salutäre ejus, allelúia, allelúia.

Sing unto the Lord, alleluia, sing unto the Lord, and bless His name: show forth His salvation from day to day, alleluia, alleluia.

POSTCOMMUNION

Tríbe nobis, Dómine, cæléstis mensæ virtúte satiáti: et desideráre quæ recta sunt, et desideráta percípere. Per Dóminum nostrum.

Grant us, O Lord, who have been nourished and strengthened at the heavenly table, both to desire that which is right, and to gain that which we desire. Through our Lord.

INTROIT: IS. 48. 20

VOCEM jucunditátis annuntiáte, et audiátur, allelúia: annuntiáte usque ad extremum terræ: liberávit Dóminus pópulum suum, alleluia, allelúia. *Ps. 65. 1-2.* Jubiláte Deo, omnis terra, psalmum dicite nómini ejus: date glóriam laudi ejus. *℟.* Glória Patri.

DECLARE it with the voice of joy, and make it known, alleluia: declare it even to the ends of the earth: The Lord hath delivered His people, alleluia, alleluia. *Ps.* Shout with joy to God, all the earth, sing ye a psalm to His name: give glory to His praise. *℟.* Glory be.

COLLECT

Deus, a quo bona cuncta procedunt largire supplicibus tuis: ut cogitémus, te inspiránte, quæ recta sunt; et, te gubernánte, éadem faciámus. Per Dóminum nostrum.
